Scholarship Ministry Overview

The Scholarship Ministry at Watson Grove Baptist Church sponsors the Pastor Curtis W. Goodwin, Sr. Scholarship. Watson Grove has been a proud supporter of this ministry for many years, allocating thousands of dollars to help its members pursue a post-secondary credential. The amount designated for this scholarship will be awarded to recipients to be used toward the purchase of books and/or college tuition and fees. This scholarship is a direct investment in the future of the youth at Watson Grove seeking educational achievement, advancement and success.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Senior in High School
2. Partner of Watson Grove
3. Academic Achievement - 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 Scale
4. Academic Interest - Must be interested in pursuing a major in Social Science (Social Work, Pastoral Care, Theology, Psychology, etc.)
5. Community Service - Displaying a commitment to the community and service to God's people
6. Involvement - Demonstrate gifts and talents through activities at or outside of school
7. Interview - Applicants will be able to present themselves and their aspirations in person

Application Process

All applications are due by April 30, 2024. Both the student and parent/guardian must sign the application. When all parts of the application are completed, submit as one package to: Scholarship@thegrovenash.org. You can also submit it by handing the complete packet to Ms. Cee-Cee Buntin or Ms. Leigh Oliver.

A complete application includes:

1. A completed, dated and signed Pastor Curtis W. Goodwin Sr. Scholarship application.
2. A most recent copy of the high school transcript.
3. Two letters of recommendations from the following people:
 - a. Non-related individual who is not from the high school (personal reference)
 - b. Academic Advisor, School Counselor, School Administrator, Teacher
4. A copy of the student's college acceptance letter from a 2yr or 4yr school. (If not available at the time of the application, please bring a copy of the letter to the interview)
5. An attached document that responds to the writing prompt attached to this application.
6. Copy of Resume (if applicable)

To keep all application information together, the student must place their name on all documents in the application package.

Note: Students can apply to all three scholarships (Watson Grove, Virginia Thompson, & Pastor Goodwin). You only have to complete the Personal Data, Church Involvement, Academic Information, Post-Secondary Information, and recommendation *one time*. If applying to multiple scholarships, you do have to complete the essay portion for each one. The essay prompts for each scholarship are attached to their specific applications.

Reverend Curtis W. Goodwin, Sr. served as the senior pastor of Watson Grove Missionary Baptist Church from 1973-2011. He loved God whole-heartedly and lived out God’s love through his service to the church and community. During Pastor Goodwin’s time at Watson Grove, he was passionate and dedicated to fostering the development of youth. He mentored young preachers, encouraged children involvement in the church, and supported youth by attending their activities outside of the church. Pastor Goodwin was an advocate and provided a voice with/for the voiceless. He provided opportunities to hear children's voices, he visited and fought for incarcerated individuals, and he believed that underrepresented populations in the community had voices that were important to hear. Pastor Goodwin wanted to see the betterment of his community through collaboration of those that lived there and having local and state government know their needs. As a graduate of American Baptist College, Pastor Goodwin was dedicated to staying connected to that community and the young people the institution developed. Pastor Goodwin was a selfless servant by giving his time, actively listening, and advocating for others.
